Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation

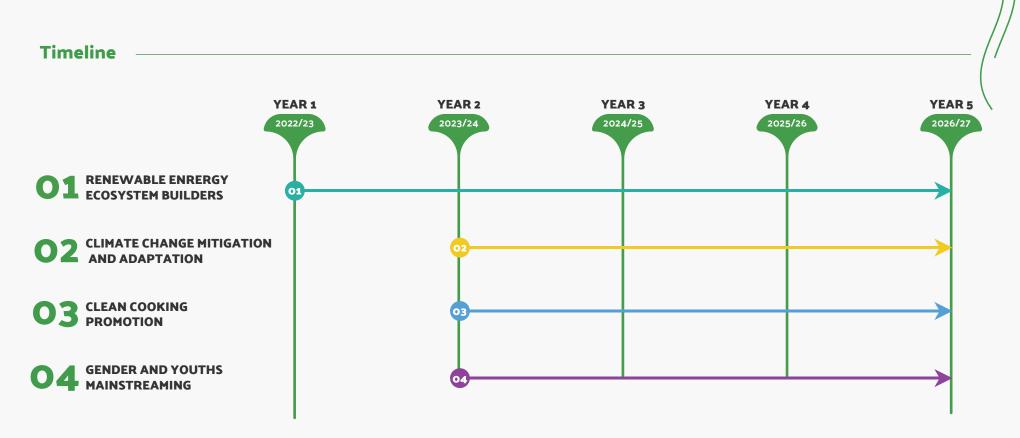
Innovatively adjust to the existing effects, while making the impact of climate change less severe by preventing or reducing (GHG) production.

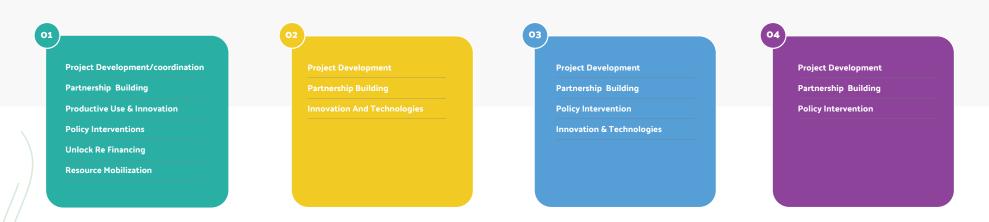


Gender and Youth Mainstreaming
